The ISSUM project is a collaborative, multi-sector, multi-institutional research initiative jointly funded by the Ontario Ministry of Research, Innovation & Science (MRIS), York University, the University of Waterloo, and a number of private sector companies and public institutions in Ontario. The goal of ISSUM is to research and develop integrated intelligent systems for sensing, analysis, simulation and 3D visualization of urban population mobility. This research will strengthen the technology sector in Ontario, increase efficiency, reduce greenhouse gases and enhance the livability of urban regions for all Ontarians.
